DECLARATION

I understand that if this entry is accepted, my participation in this TRACK ACCESS event is subject to the undertaking and indemnities in the General Rules of the Aintree Circuit Club and that the Club, CCUK Media Ltd and Landowners are absolved from any liability that may arise as a result of my use of this facility.

I also declare that:

- I understand that this is a non-competitive event. Whilst racing is not permitted at any time, vehicles will be driven at high speeds in a sporting environment and I acknowledge that in such circumstances despite the organisers taking all reasonable precautions, unavoidable accidents can happen and I therefore declare that I shall be present at my own risk.
- I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event, and that I am competent to do so.
- I understand the nature and type of the event and the potential risk inherent with motor sport, and agree to accept that risk.
- To the best of my belief I possess the appropriate standard of competence for an event of the type to which this entry relates and that the vehicle to be used is suitable and roadworthy for the event having regard to the course and the speeds which will be reached.
- I understand that should I at any time during this event be suffering from any physical or mental disability whether permanent or temporary that is likely to affect prejudicially my normal control of the vehicle, I must not take part unless I have declared such disability to The Aintree Circuit Club or CCUK Media Limited, who, following such declaration, agree to accept my participation in the event. I further declare that I shall inform the organisers immediately, should any change in my condition occur during the event that I have reason to believe would adversely affect my ability to continue to safely participate in the event.

The form must not be signed by anyone else on behalf of the driver/entrant.

IMPORTANT: No one under the age of 18 years shall be permitted to be carried in any vehicle participating in this event without the written permission of their parent or guardian. Drivers must not take part in the event whilst under the influence of drink or drugs.
